









## Registrations evolution by month



#### Food and Beverage

## **Audiovisual**

All meeting rooms were equipped with videoprojector and computer for powerpoint projections.

For interactive sessions a televoting system was used.

The slide preview located in room 1.09 and 1.14 were equipped with 6 PC's. Macintosh computers were not used. The slide preview was related to all the meeting rooms via intranet system, so all presentations were sent from the slide preview directly to the meeting rooms.

#### Poster session online

The web-based platform, PosterSessionOnline, was chosen to manage the posters. All submitted posters can be viewed at the 35<sup>th</sup> ECC virtual poster gallery at the website of the congress.

#### **Internet area**

A cyber corner with 8 computers and a printer was available to all participants during the congress.


